




I BELIEVE IN CHRIST Text by Bruce R. McConkie

The Heritage Youth Chorus at American Heritage School is a faith-centered choral ensemble with locations in Utah and Salt Lake counties. The mission of the choir is to build musical excellence and enduring faith in the lives of choir members and listeners. Since its founding in 2009, the choir has performed frequently on Temple Square and has collaborated with David Archuleta, BYU Vocal Point, Paul Cardall, Dallyn Vail Bayles, David Osmond, Marie Osmond, Laura Osnes, and Nathan Pacheco. Choir members were featured on the inaugural Christmas Under the Stars special produced by BYUTV, featuring GENTRI and Lexi Walker. In 2009, Heritage Youth Chorus members were heard singing side-by-side with the Tabernacle Choir and Natalie Cole in their annual Christmas concert. In 2016, the choir was invited to premier a new piece in the Salt Lake Tabernacle by Paul Cardall with text by David A. Bednar entitled "One By One." In 2019, the Youth Chorus released a stand-alone album entitled "Beautiful Savior" and collaborated with composer Michael R. Hicks on a recording and video of the iconic EFY Medley, "As Sisters in Zion/We'll Bring the World His Truth." Recently, the choir collaborated with violinist Jenny Oaks Baker on "The Redeemer: An Easter Celebration," which has received over 11 million views worldwide. Each summer, the choir embarks on a service and performance tour, presenting musical firesides for stakes of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints throughout the country. The choir has performed over 60 musical firesides in 25 U.S. states. The Heritage Youth Chorus is the premier touring ensemble in the Heritage Youth Choirs organization, which provides faith-centered singing experiences for children of all ages throughout the Wasatch Front.
