## ABOUT THE AUTHOR Geneve Cornell

Geneve Taft Smith was born August 29, 1921 in Santaquin, Utah. She was the eldest daughter in a family of three brothers and five sisters. She graduated from Payson High School in 1939.

Geneve was a highly respected member of her community and maintained an active role in church, political and cultural activities. She was invited to teach at American Heritage School by H. Verlan Andersen, founder of the school.

Geneve's teaching career spanned 20 years during which time she served seven years as Director of American Heritage School. She was committed to instilling a fierce pride of patriotism and love of history in her students. She wrote and produced several programs during her career as a teacher including:

Statue of Liberty Centennial Program (1986)
William Dawes and Paul Revere Program
Miracle at Philadelphia (1987)
Bill of Rights (1989, performed to honor the ratification)
Columbus Quincentenary Program (1992)

Bethany's involvement with the Patriotic Program began in 2013 when she joined the 5th grade faculty at AHS. Seeking to maintain the original Spirit and depth of Geneve's work, she has accepted assignments over the years to revise and add to the script for theatrical flow and extend its reach. She often turned to her husband, Calvin Cory (artist, writer and composer), who would translate their ideas into literary and visual refinement. Both feel passionate about the principles Geneve presented and honored to support the meaning and tradition of the program.

## PROGRAM NOTES

#### MAGNA CARTA

The English document known in Latin as the Magna Carta was a decisive step in the development of constitutional government in England. Unhappy with the oppressive actions of King John, a council of barons and church leaders under the direction of the archbishop of Canterbury, Stephen Langton, met to draw up a list of rights they wanted John to grant them. Twice the king refused to sign the document. Finally, though under military pressure, King John signed the charter in 1215. The document came to be recognized as the foundation of the fundamental law of England. The ideals contained in the Magna Carta eventually became part of the framework of the Constitution of the United States.

#### **COLUMBUS**

God inspired "a man among the gentiles" (1 Nephi 13:12) who, by the Spirit of God, was led to rediscover the land of America and bring this rich new land to the attention of the people in Europe. That man was Christopher Columbus, who testified that he was inspired in what he did. "Our Lord," said Columbus, "unlocked my mind, sent me upon the sea, and gave me fire for the deed. Those who heard of my enterprise called it foolish, mocked me, and laughed. But who can doubt that the Holy Ghost inspired me?" (Columbus' Journal re-printed in Teachings of Ezra Taft Benson p. 577). Columbus' first voyage was one of the most significant achievements of recorded human history and was, as well, a demonstration of Columbus's supremacy as a mariner and navigator. His navigational skills became even more remarkable in view of the fact that his ships were of such inferior quality. At the time, the seaworthy ships were all being used to transport the Jews from Spain. By royal decree, all unbaptized Jews were to be out of Spain by August 2, 1492. Columbus had three compelling reasons that motivated him for this staggering undertaking. He was possessed with the idea of 1) sailing west to reach the east, and 2) to gain glory and honor for Spain. While these reasons were of great concern to him, they were of no more importance than his third motive. He wanted 3) to take Christianity to the people he would encounter. He gave all the credit to his God for his accomplishments counting himself unworthy and blessed beyond his merits. His statement, "What the human understanding could not attain, the divine will has granted to human efforts," characterizes his life.

#### FOUNDING FATHERS

Speaking of the Founding Fathers, President Wilford Woodruff said, "They are the best spirits the God of Heaven could find on the face of the earth." President Ezra Taft Benson stated that the Founding Fathers "were held in reserve to collectively come in the time and at the place when one of history's greatest crises demanded their talents." Undoubtedly one of the most venerable councils of outstanding, inspired men ever assembled, the Founding Fathers were led and directed by God. They were instrumental in bringing human rights and dignity to their highest level. Their utterances and writing fill volumes and the precedents they set have served as a timeless model for governments worldwide. The women of the era were no less remarkable. Abigail Adams, wife of John Adams, with her son and future president, John Quincy Adams, watched the British burn Charleston and heard the cannon roar at the Battle of Bunker Hill. John called Abigail "as fiery as a young grenadier."
